- ➤ Decisions have been made trusting Jesus Christ as personal Savior.
- Can obtain favorable references as indicated within this packet.
- All students seeking admission are in good standing at their previous school.
- > Secondary students must express a genuine desire to attend Westlake Christian Academy.

PACKET CONTENTS

Admission to Westlake Christian Academy is based on the Admissions Policies and Procedures stated on the inside cover of this packet. It is important that the contents of this packet be read carefully and completely. The components are:

Admission Policies and Procedures

The school board has established the following guidelines for admission to Westlake Christian Academy:

- The Administration is given the authority to admit qualified students to WCA.
- > The processing of applications cannot be started without the receipt of all required Application forms and fees.
- > One or both parents <u>must</u> subscribe to the policies, procedures, philosophy, standards, and statement of faith of Westlake Christian Academy as outlined in admissions materials & the parent/student handbook.
- No student will be admitted who:
 - Shows low academic performance as indicated by standardized testing program, report cards, or WCA admissions test.
 - Has failed the most recent grade level or semester prior to application.
 - Has not been in good standing at their current school(s) for at least the prior semester.
 - Has a recent history of emotional or disciplinary problems.
 - Has been suspended or expelled within the last year.
 - Has a court record.
 - ♦ Comes from a non-Christian home—a Christian home being defined as: a home where one or both parents have received Jesus Christ as their personal Lord and Savior.(1 Cor. 7:14)
 - ♦ Has an identified or probable Learning Disability beyond our scope of expertise.
- Children applying for the two-day Pre-School program must be three (3) years of age by September 1; and four (4) years of age by September 1 for the three-day Pre-K program. Children applying for admission to Kindergarten must be five (5) years of age on or before September 1. Any child applying for First grade must be six (6) years of age on or before September 1.
- Westlake Christian Academy admits students of any race, color, national or ethnic origin to all the rights, privileges, programs, and activities generally accorded or made available to students at the school. We do not discriminate on the basis of race, color, national or ethnic origin in administration of educational policies, admissions policies, scholarship and loan programs, and athletic and other school administered programs.

Instructions

- 1. Prior to formally applying you are welcome to tour the school, make an appointment to discuss school programs, ect. Depending on the calendar, the applicant may be invited to "shadow" (spend a day with us in the classroom).
- 2. To initiate the formal process complete the enclosed Student Application and return it to the school office along with a non-refundable application fee of \$25.00. Applications will be processed only after all forms are returned.

For each student applying the following forms must be completed and information provided:

- 4. The application will be reviewed and qualified applicants and parents will be scheduled for an interview. A final decision regarding admission will be made after the interview and the prospective family will be notified as soon as possible.
- 5. Upon Acceptance, a \$250 registration fee will be due for the first child, and \$100 for each child thereafter.
- 6. Since the academic standards at Westlake Christian Academy maybe higher than those of other institutions, an achievement test may be given to all new students to determine an appropriate grade level placement. The school does not want to place undue stress on students who possibly would find the work too difficult if misassigned.
