The Book of James (ESV)

Date	Reference	Verse
June 15	<u>James 1:2-4</u>	Jas 1:2-Jas 1:4 ESV Count it all joy, my brothers, when you meet trials of various kinds, for you know that the testing of your faith produces steadfastness. And let steadfastness have its full effect, that you may be perfect and complete, lacking in nothing.
June 22	<u>James 1:5</u> <u>James 1:12</u>	Jas 1:5 ESV If any of you lacks wisdom, let him ask God, who gives generously to all without reproach, and it will be given him. Jas 1:12 ESV Blessed is the man who remains steadfast under trial, for when he has stood the test he will receive the crown of life, which God has promised to those who love him.
June 29	<u>James 1:17</u> <u>James 1:22</u>	Jas 1:17 ESV Every good gift and every perfect gift is from above, coming down from the Father of lights, with whom there is no variation or shadow due to change. Jas 1:22 ESV But be doers of the word, and not hearers only, deceiving yourselves.
July 6	<u>James 1:26 - 27</u>	Jas 1:26-Jas 1:27 ESV If anyone thinks he is religious and does not bridle his tongue but deceives his heart, this person's religion is worthless. Religion that is pure and undefiled before God the Father is this: to visit orphans and widows in their affliction, and to keep oneself unstained from the world.
July 13	<u>James 2:8-9</u> <u>James 2:26</u>	Jas 2:8-Jas 2:9 ESV If you really fulfill the royal law according to the Scripture, "You shall love your neighbor as yourself," you are doing well. But if you show partiality, you are committing sin and are convicted by the law as transgressors. Jas 2:26 ESV For as the body apart from the spirit is dead, so also faith apart from works is dead.
July 20	<u>James 3:7-8</u> <u>James 3:13</u>	Jas 3:7-Jas 3:8 ESV For every kind of beast and bird, of reptile and sea creature, can be tamed and has been tamed by mankind, but no human being can tame the tongue. It is a restless evil, full of deadly poison Jas 3:13 ESV Who is wise and understanding among you? By his good conduct let him show his works in the meekness of wisdom.
July 27	<u>James 3:18</u> <u>James 4:6-8</u>	Jas 3:18 ESV And a harvest of righteousness is sown in peace by those who make peace. Jas 4:6-Jas 4:8 ESV But he gives more grace. Therefore it says, "God opposes the proud but gives grace to the humble." Submit yourselves therefore to God. Resist the devil, and he will flee from you. Draw near to God, and he will draw near to you. Cleanse your hands, you sinners, and purify your hearts, you double-minded.

August 3	<u>James 4:12</u> <u>James 4:14</u>	Jas 4:12 ESV There is only one lawgiver and judge, he who is able to save and to destroy. But who are you to judge your neighbor? Jas 4:14 ESV yet you do not know what tomorrow will bring. What is your life? For you are a mist that appears for a little time and then vanishes.
August 10	<u>James 5:12</u>	Jas 5:12 ESV But above all, my brothers, do not swear, either by heaven or by earth or by any other oath, but let your "yes" be yes and your "no" be no, so that you may not fall under condemnation.
August 17	<u>James 5:16</u>	Jas 5:16 ESV Therefore, confess your sins to one another and pray for one another, that you may be healed. The prayer of a righteous person has great power as it is working.
